INSTRUCTIONS FOR PATIENTS RECEIVING SEDATION

With the aid of sedation, your surgery will be very pleasant. The medication will be given intravenously and, in most cases, local anesthesia will also be utilized.

It is absolutely essential that you have a responsible adult (18 or older) bring you to the office, drive you home, and care for you the day of surgery. **This person needs to wait in their car on our premises throughout your procedure. We cannot do the procedure if they leave.** You will need to arrange to have someone at home with you the afternoon and night of surgery.

The profound effects of the sedation will subside prior to your discharge from the office. However, you should plan to go home, stay comfortable and avoid extraneous activities for the remainder of the day.

If surgery is in the morning, do not eat or drink anything after midnight the night prior to the surgery. If medication is needed prior to surgery, swallow it with only a small amount of water. The only medications that should be taken prior to surgery are high blood pressure, heart medication, or if your doctor instructed you to take other medications that they felt was necessary. **Do not eat or drink anything else until after your procedure. If you eat or drink anything 8 hours prior to surgery it will have serious consequences with the anesthesia and your procedure may be cancelled.**

If you are a minor, at least one parent or legal guardian must be with you.

Get a good night's sleep before your surgery.

You should wear loose fitting, comfortable clothing with short sleeves. Do not wear a tight collar or necktie. False eyelashes or contact lenses should not be worn. Wear low heel shoes. Also, you should try to empty your bladder immediately prior to your surgery.

If you develop a cold, sore throat, upset stomach, diarrhea, etc., prior to surgery, please notify us as soon as possible.

We advise that you purchase protein drinks (Ensure, Boost, etc.) and have them in your house for after the surgery.
